



Diamond Lace Shawl

Skill Level



Finished Measurements

Approximately 65" long x 16" wide, excluding edging and fringe.

Materials



Yarn: Deborah Norville Collection **SERENITY GARDEN** – 8 balls DN800-11 Earth (100% microfine acrylic; 170 yards/156 meters; 2 ounces/60 grams)
Crochet Hook: F-5 (3.75mm)

Gauge

20 sc and 22 sc rows = 4" (gauge is difficult to measure in lace pattern – work swatch entirely in sc). *Use any size hook necessary to obtain the specified gauge.*

Abbreviations

beg – beginning
ch – chain
dc – double crochet
lp – loop
mm – millimeter
rem – remaining
rep – repeat
RS – right side
sc – single crochet
sl st – slip stitch
sp – space
st(s) – stitch(es)

Shawl

Beg at long bottom edge, ch 362.

Row 1 (RS): Sc in second ch from hook and in each of next 3 sc, ch 7, sk next 5 ch, [sc in each of next 7 ch, ch 7, sk next 5 ch] 29 times, sc in each of last 4 ch; turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc, ch 4, sc in center of next ch-7 sp, [ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, ch 4, sc in center of next ch-7 sp] 29 times, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of last 3 sc; turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-4 sp] 29 times, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of last 2 sc; turn.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in first sc, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-4 sp] 29 times, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in last 2 sc; turn.

Row 5: Ch 9, sc in first ch-4 sp, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, [ch 7, sk next ch-4 sp and sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in each of next 5 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp] 29 times, ch 7, dtr in last sc; turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in first dtr, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc, [ch 4, sc in next ch-7 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 5 sc] 29 times, ch 4, sc in fifth ch of turning ch below; turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in first sc and in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in each of next 3 sc] 29 times, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in last sc; turn.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in each of first 2 sc and in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc, [ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in each of next 3 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 4, sk next sc, sc in next sc] 29 times, ch 4, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in each of last 2 sc; turn.

Row 9: Ch 1, sc in each of first 3 sc and in next ch-4 sp, ch 7, sk next sc [sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in next each of next 5 sc, sc in next ch-4 sp, ch 7, sk next sc] 29 times, sc in next ch-4 sp, sc in each of last 3 sc; turn.

Rep Rows 2-9 eight more times; fasten off.

Border: Working along long edge, with RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in first sc.

Row 1: Ch 1, sc in same st as joining, ch 5, dc in fourth ch from hook and in next ch, *(sc, ch 3, sc) in next ch-7 sp, ch 5, dc in fourth ch from hook and in next ch, sc in center sc of next 7-sc group, ch 5, dc in fourth ch from hook and in next ch; rep from * across, ending with sc in last sc; fasten off. Rep along other long edge.

Rnd 2: With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in first ch-5 lp along one long edge, ([dc, ch 3, sl st in third ch from hook – picot made, dc] 3 times) in same ch-5 lp, * ([dc, picot, dc] 3 times) in next ch-5 lp; rep from * across long edge, (dc, ch 2) evenly along short edge; rep from * across rem edges; join with a sl st in first dc; fasten off.

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
