



Woven Stripes Throw

Skill Level



Throw measures approximately 46" square, including edging.

Materials



Yarn: Deborah Norville Collection **Serenity Garden**

- DN800-04 Gems (MC) – 10 balls
- DN800-03 Hibiscus (CC) – 3 balls

Crochet hook: US F-5 (3.75mm) or *size to obtain gauge*

Extras: Yarn needle

Gauge

18 dc and 10 rows = 4". *Use any size hook necessary to obtain the specified gauge.*

Abbreviations

CC – contrast color

ch – chain

dc – double crochet

hdc – half double crochet

lp(s) – loop(s)

MC – main color

rem – remain(ing)

rep – repeat

sc – single crochet

sk – skip

st(s) – stitch(es)

yo – yarn over

* – repeat the instructions after asterisk as specified

[] – repeat instructions between brackets the number of times specified.

Special Stitch

Bobble: [Yo, insert hook in specified st and pull up a lp, yo and draw yarn through 2 lps on hook] 5 times, yo and pull yarn through all 6 lps on hook.



Square (make 49): With MC, ch 27.

Row 1: Dc in third ch from hook and each rem ch across, turn – 26 dc.

Rows 2–14: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in each dc across, turn. Fasten off at end of Row 14, leaving a long end of yarn.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing, sew squares together so there are 7 squares across and 7 squares down, alternating direction of rows for a woven effect (see photo).

Edging:

Note: Edge is worked separately on each side of afghan.

With right side of afghan facing you, join CC in upper right corner.

Row 1: Work 26 sc across each square along edge, turn – 182 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each rem sc across, turn – 183 sc.

Row 4: Ch 2 (counts as first dc), dc in each of next 6 sc, * ch 1, sk 1 sc, dc in each of next 7 sc; rep from * across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, * sc in next dc, hdc in next dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, hdc in next dc, sc in next dc, sc in ch-1 sp; rep from * across, ending with sc in next dc, hdc in next dc, dc in each of next 3 dc, hdc in next dc, sc in last dc, turn.

Row 6: Ch 1, * sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 3 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in each of next 2 sts; rep from * across, ending with sc in next st, hdc in next st, dc in next st, 3 dc in next st, dc in next st, hdc in next st, sc in last st, turn – 229 sts.

Row 7: Ch 1, * sc in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of next 3 sts, work bobble in next st; rep from * across, ending with sc in in each of next 3 sts, 2 sc in each of next 3 sts, sc in each of last 3 sts; fasten off.
Rep edging on each side of afghan.

Corner Insert (make 4): With CC, ch 2.

Row 1: 3 sc in second ch from hook, turn – 3 sc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 3: Ch 1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc, sc in last sc – 4 sc.

Row 4: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 5: Ch 1, sc in next sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in last sc, turn – 6 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

Row 7: Ch 1, sc in each of next 2 sc, 2 sc in each of next 2 sc, sc in each of last 2 sc, turn – 8 sc.

Row 8: Ch 1, sc in next sc, hdc in next sc, dc in next sc, [yo, insert hook and pull up a lp, yo and draw yarn through 2 lps on hook] 3 times in each of next 2 sc, yo and draw yarn through all 7 lps on hook, dc in next sc, hdc in next sc, sc in last sc; fasten off.

Sew one Corner Insert to sides of Edging at each corner. Weave in ends.

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
