Flowers in the Window Throw

Skill Level



Size: 45" x 45"

Materials



Deborah Norville Collection: Serenity Worsted Weight

- 400-01 White – 2 balls
- 400-24 Pool Blue – 2 balls
- 400-32 True Blue – 2 balls
- 400-31 Blue – 1 ball
- 400-36 Cactus – 1 ball
- 400-04 Canary – 1 ball
- 400-13 Pink Carnation – 1 ball
- 400-20 Hyacinth – 1 ball
- 400-22 Purple – 1 ball
- 400-29 Marina Blue – 1 ball
- 400-33 Kiwi – 1 ball

Crochet hook: US-1/9 (5.5mm)

Extras: Yarn needle

Gauge: 12 sc = 3½" and 16 sc = 4". Use any size hook necessary to obtain the specified gauge.

Abbreviations

- beg – beginning
- ch – chain
- dc – double crochet
- lp(s) – loop(s)
- mm – millimeter
- sc – single crochet
- sk – skip
- sl – slip
- st(s) – stitch(es)
- * – repeat instructions after asterisk as specified
- [] – repeat instructions inside brackets the number of times specified

Pattern Notes

Throw is formed by crocheting 16 small squares, then joining 4 small squares into one large square, then joining 4 large squares into one final square for center of afghan. A border is then crocheted around the center. Refer to diagram for color placement.



Small Square (make 16)

With center color, ch 4.

Rnd 1 (RS): 2 dc in fourth ch from hook, [ch 2, 3 dc in same ch] 3 times, ch 2; join with a sl st in top of beg ch.

Rnd 2: Sl st in each of next 2 dc and in next ch-2 sp, (ch 3, 2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with a sl st in top of beg ch-3; fasten off.

Rnd 3: With RS facing, join next color with a sl st in any ch-2 corner sp; ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1; rep from * around; join with a sl st in third ch of beg ch-3; fasten off.

Rnd 4: With RS facing, join next color with a sl st in any ch-2 corner sp; ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, ch 1, [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] twice, * (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next corner ch-2 sp, ch 1, [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] twice; rep from * around; join with a sl st in third ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, sc in same st and in each dc and ch around, working (2 sc, ch 1, 2 sc) in center ch of next corner; join with a sl st in first sc; fasten off.

Begin working in rows.

Row 1: With RS facing, join next color with a sc in back lp of sc to left of any corner ch-1; sc in back lp of each sc across to corner ch, 3 sc in corner ch, sc in back lp of each sc across to next corner ch; turn, leaving remaining sts unworked – 41 sc.

Rows 2-4: Ch 1, working in both lps, sc in each sc across to corner sc, 3 sc in corner sc, sc in each sc across; turn – 47 sc.
Fasten off.

Row 5: With RS facing, join next color with sc in first sc; sc in each sc across to corner sc, 3 sc in corner sc, sc in each sc across; turn – 49 sc.

Row 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc across to corner sc, 3 sc in corner sc, sc in each sc across; fasten off – 51 sc.

Row 7: With RS facing, join next color with sc in first sc; sc in each sc across to corner sc, 3 sc in corner sc, sc in each sc across; turn – 53 sc.

Rows 8 and 9: Ch 1, sc in each sc across to corner sc, 3 sc in corner sc, sc in each sc across; turn – 57 sc.
Fasten off.

Assembly

With WS together, whipstitch sets of 4 squares tog through inside lps only, making sure all flowers are in the center. Sew 4 large squares together in same manner to form center of afghan.

Border Strips (make 4)

With White, ch 131.

Row 1 (RS): Dc in fourth ch from hook (3 sk chs count as one dc) and each ch across; turn – 129 dc.

Row 2: Ch 1, sk first dc, * dc in next dc, sl st in next dc; rep from * across; turn.

Row 3: Ch 3, sk first st, dc in each st across; turn – 129 dc.

Row 4: Rep Row 2; fasten off.

Row 5: With RS facing, join Pool Blue with sl st in first st, ch 3 (counts as one dc), dc in next st and in each st across; turn.

Rows 6-8: Rep Rows 2-4.

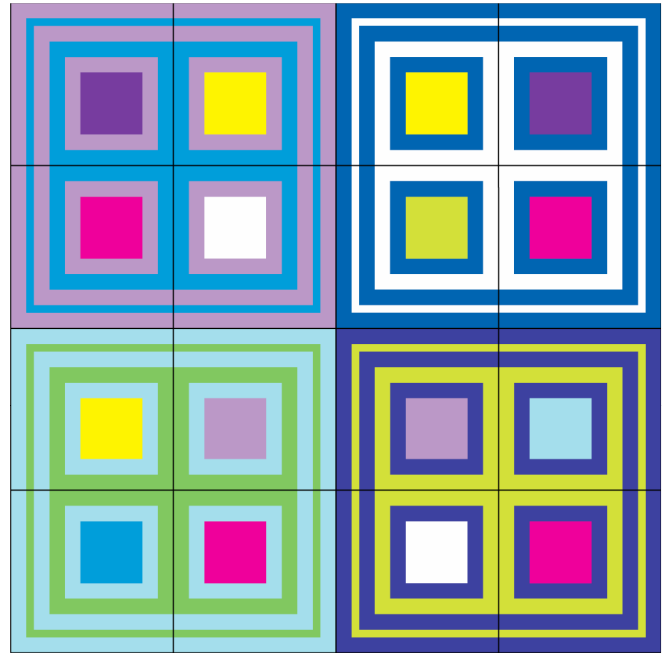
Rows 9-12: With True Blue, rep Rows 5-8. Fasten off.

Joining

With WS of one strip and WS of center of afghan facing, join White with sc in first st of both pieces, sc in each st across, leaving excess length of border strip free; do not fasten off. Holding WS of next strip with next side of center of afghan, sc in each st across. Repeat for remaining 2 sides; join with slip st to first sc, fasten off.

Sew excess length of each strip to side of adjacent strip.

Weave in ends.
