Ribbed Scarf and Hat Set

Skill Level



BEGINNER

Scarf

Approximately 7.5" x 60"

Hat

Fits head circumference 21"

Materials



Yarn:

- Deborah Norville Collection **Serenity Chunky**
Weight 600-08 Stormy – 3 balls

Knitting needles: US 10.5 (6.50mm) straight and double-pointed needles *or size to obtain gauge*

Extras: Yarn needle

Gauge

14 sts and 17 rows = 4" in K2, P2 rib. *Use any size needles to obtain the specified gauge.*

Abbreviations

Dec – decrease

K – knit

K2tog – knit two stitches together

P – purl

Rem – remaining

Rep – repeat

Rnd – round

Sts – stitches

WS – wrong side



SCARF

Using straight needles, cast on 26 sts.

Work in K2, P2 rib as follows:

Row 1 (WS): P2, *K2, P2; rep from * to end.

Row 2: K2, *P2, K2; rep from * to end.

Rep these 2 rows until piece measures 60" or desired length.

Bind off all sts. Weave in all loose ends.

HAT

Using double-pointed needles, cast on 76 sts. Place marker and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist sts. Work in K2, P2 rib as follows:

Rnd 1: *K2, P2; rep from * to end.

Rep this rnd until piece measures 8".

Dec Rnd: *K2tog; rep from * to end – 38 sts rem.

Cut yarn, leaving a tail long enough to thread through rem sts.

Pull yarn to close top of hat tightly. Weave in all loose ends.
