One ball Chunky Yarn

SECTION ONE - SMALL FLAP

Cast on 32 stitches

K1 p1 to end of row

Repeat for 5 rows

Knit stockinette stitch for 13 rows (about 2" inches)

End on purl row

Sl 1 k1 pssso; sl1 k1 pssso knit 24 ; k 2 tog ; k2 tog;

Purl 1 row

Sl ,1 k1, pssso; sl 1, k1, pssso, knit 20 ; k 2 tog ; k2 tog;

Purl 1 row (24 stitches)

Knit row

Purl row

END SECTION ONE

SECTION TWO - BODY

K 1, inc 1 ; k 1; inc 1; k 20; inc 1 ; k 1; inc 1; k 1;

Purl one row. (28 stitches)

K 1, inc 1 ; k 1; inc 1; k 24; inc 1 ; k 1; inc 1; k 1;

Purl next row (32 stitches)

Continue Stockinette stitch for 9 1/2 inches. End on purl row.

Next knit row, sl 1. K 1; pssso; sl 1; k 1; pssso; knit 24; k 2 tog; k 2 tog

Sl 1 , p 1, pssso; sl 1 p 1, pssso purl 20 ; p 2 tog, p 2 tog

END SECTION TWO

SECTION THREE - NECK

K 6; switch to double pointed needles

Work neck of bottle

* p 1, k 1 - repeat from * for next 11 stitches (leave remaining existing stitches on original needle, you will later need to move the work on either side of neck to stitch holders) ; cast on 10 stitches and continue rib stitch for 12 rows (or 2 1/2 inches).

Cast/bind off. Break yarn

END SECTION THREE

SECTION FOUR - BACK FLAP

Rejoin yarn on purl side of work. Remove right side from stitch holder and purl next 6 stitches. Pick up each next 12 stitches from neck and purl across ,then pick up original work and purl across to end of row.

K across next row

P 1, inc 1, p1, inc 1, purl across row until 2 stitches remain. Inc 1, p1, inc 1, p 1.

K 1, inc 1, k 1, inc 1 , knit across row until 2 stitches remain, inc 1, k 1, inc 1, k 1

Continue stockinette stitch for 6 inches, (this section will just meet Section ONE when folded)

K 1 p 1 to end of row

Repeat for 5 rows.

Cast/bind off. Break yarn Turn inside out, sew sides together. Affix velcro tab inside closure. Insert standard 2 qt. Water bottle
