Anchors Aweigh Sweater

Skill Level



Instructions are for size 6; changes for sizes 8 and 10 are in parentheses.

Finished Chest Measurements: 27 (29, 31)"

Materials



Deborah Norville Collection: Serenity Sport Weight

300-43 Camel (MC) – 3 (3, 4) balls

300-09 Rustic (CA) – 1 (1, 1) ball

300-40 Pine Green (CB) – 1 (1, 1) ball

Knitting needles: US 6 (4mm) straight needles and 16" circular needle

Extras: Stitch markers, 2 cable needles, yarn needle

Gauge

23 sts and 32 rows = 4" in St st. *Use any size needles necessary to obtain the specified gauge.*

Abbreviations

beg – beginning

cm – centimeters

cn – cable needle

inc – increasing

k – knit

k2tog – knit next two stitches together (1 stitch decrease)

MC – main color

mm – millimeters

p – purl

patt – pattern

pm – place marker

rep – repeat

RS – right side

sl – slip

ssk – slip 2 sts as if to knit, knit same 2 stitches together

St st – Stockinette stitch (knit right side rows, purl wrong side rows)

st(s) – stitch(es)

WS – wrong side

yo – yarn over

***** – repeat instructions after asterisk the specified number of times

[] – repeat instructions inside brackets as specified



Back

With MC cast on 80 (86, 92) sts.

Row 1: [K2, p2] across to last 0 (2, 0) sts, Ko (2, 0).

Row 2 (RS): Po (2, 0), [k2, p2] across.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until ribbing measures 1½", ending with a WS row.

Beg with a knit row (RS), work in St st until piece measures 9 (10½, 12)" from beg.

Mark each end of last row for base of armholes. Work even until armholes measure 7 (7½, 8)" from marked row, ending with a WS row. Bind off all sts, marking first and last 25 (28, 30) sts for each shoulder.

Front

With MC cast on 80 (86, 92) sts.

Work ribbing same as Back.

Row 1: Knit across inc 5 sts evenly– 85 (91, 97) sts.

Row 2: Purl.

Row 3: K23 (26, 29), pm, work Row 1 of Cable Patt over 10 sts, p19, work Row 1 of Cable Patt over 10 sts, pm, k23 (26, 29).

Row 4: Purl to marker, work Row 2 of Cable Patt over 10 sts, k19, work Row 2 of Cable Patt over next 10 sts, p23 (26, 29).

Continue in established patt until piece measures 8 (10, 12)" from beg, ending with a WS row.

Size 10 only: Mark each end of last row for base of armholes.

All sizes – Begin Anchor Patt

Row 1 (RS): Knit to marker, work next row of Cable Patt over next 10 sts, work Row 1 of Anchor Patt over next 19 sts, work next row of Cable Patt over next 10 sts, knit across.

Row 2 (WS): Purl to marker, work next row of Cable Patt over next 10 sts, work next row of Anchor Patt, work next row of Cable Patt over next 10 sts, p23 (26, 29). Continue to work in established patt.

Sizes 6 and 8 only: When work measures 9 (10½)" from beg, mark each end of last row for base of armholes.

All Sizes: Continue to work in established patt through Row 38 of Anchor Patt, then work center 19 sts in Reverse St st (purl on WS, knit on RS) until armholes measure 5 (5½, 6)", ending with a WS row.

Shape Neck

Work across 32 (35, 37) sts, join new yarn and bind off center 21 (21, 23) sts, work across – 32 (35, 37) sts each side.

Working each side separately, at each neck edge bind off 3 sts, then bind off 2 sts, then decrease 1 st every RS row twice – 25 (28, 30) sts each side.

Work even until armholes measure same as Back to shoulder.

Bind off remaining sts.

Sleeve (make 2)

With MC cast on 38 (40, 42) sts.

Row 1: [K2, p2] across to last 2 (0, 2) sts, K2 (0, 2).

Row 2 (RS): P2 (0, 2), [k2, p2] across.

Rep Rows 1 and 2 until ribbing measures 1½", ending with a WS row.

Note: Begin working in stripe sequence as follows: 8 rows CA, 8 rows CB, 8 rows MC.

Beg with a knit row (RS), work in stripe sequence in St st, inc one st at each edge every 4 rows, 21 (23, 25) times – 80 (86, 92) sts.

Work even until sleeve measures 13 (14, 15½)" from beg, ending by working a WS row.

Bind off all sts.

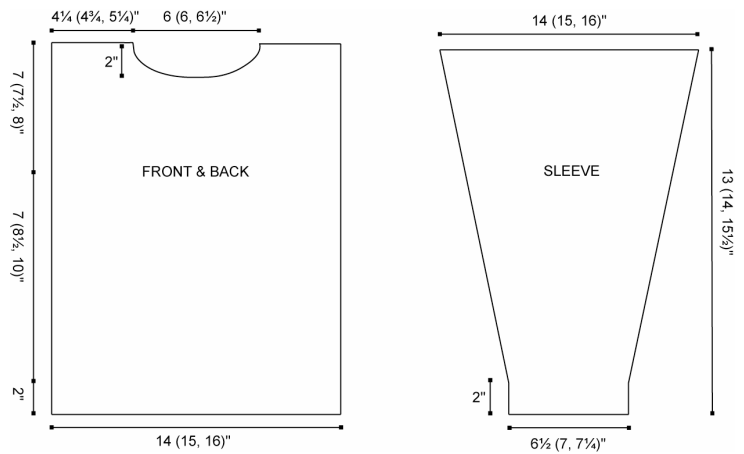
Finishing

Sew shoulder seams. Sew sleeves to body, placing between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neckband

With RS facing, using circular needle and beg at left shoulder, pick up 76 (76, 80) sts evenly spaced around. Work in k2, p2 ribbing for ¾". Bind off all sts in ribbing patt.

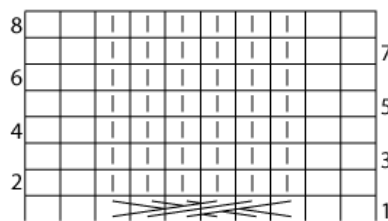
Weave in ends.



Patterns Stitch Charts:

RS rows are read from right to left, WS rows are read from left to right.

Cable Pattern

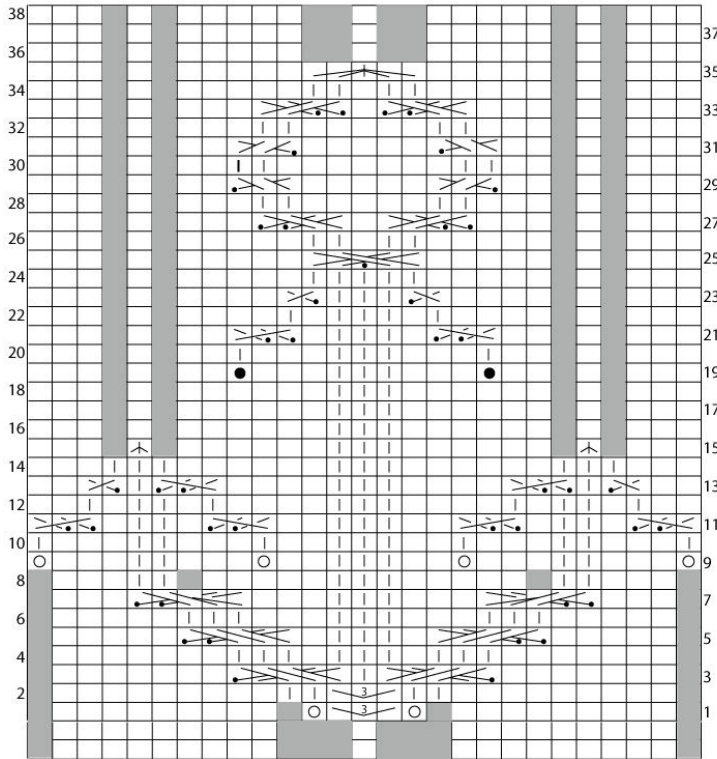



□ = knit on RS, purl on WS


□ = purl on RS, knit on WS


□ = C3B: slip 3 sts to cn and hold in back, k3, k3 from cn.


Anchor stitch patt




 = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front, sl 1 st to a 2nd cn and hold in front, k2; p1 from 2nd cn; k2 from 1st cn.


 = slip 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k3; p1, k1 from cn.


 = slip 3 sts to cn and hold in front, k1, p1; k3 from cn.

 = slip 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k3, p2 from cn.

 = slip 3 sts to cn and hold in front, p2, k3 from cn.


 = slip 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k1, k2tog; p2 from cn.


 = slip 3 sts to cn and hold in front, p2; ssk, k1 from cn.


 = sl 3 sts tog knitwise, k2tog, pass the slipped sts over the k2tog st (5 sts decreased to 1 st).


 = knit on RS, purl on WS


 = purl on RS, knit on WS


 = yo, yarn over


 = no stitch


 = slip 2 sts tog knitwise, k1, pass slipped sts over the knitted st (3 sts decreased to 1 st).


 = k1, yo, k1, yo, k1 in same st (1 st increased to 5 sts); turn your work to WS, p5; turn your work to RS, sl 3 sts tog knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped sts over the k2tog st (5 sts decreased to 1 st).


 = sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, p1; k1 from cn.


 = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k1; p1 from cn.


 = sl 1 st to cn and hold in front, p2; k1 from cn.


 = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k1; p2 from cn.

 = sl 1 st to cn and hold in back, k2; p1 from cn.

 = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front, p1; k2 from cn.

 = k1, yo, k1 in same st (1 st increased to 3 sts)

 = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in back, k2; p2 from cn.

 = sl 2 sts to cn and hold in front, p2; k2 from cn.

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
